

Evangel University is pleased to announce a new program designed specifically for missionary kids, missionary associates, and missionaries!

The new program allows AGWM personnel and missionary kids (who have attained at least a high school junior status) to earn college credit for work on the field and in conjunction with PFO and SOM.

Features designed specifically for missionaries include:

- Streamlined application process. Missions appointment fulfills reference requirements.
- Fifty percent discount off of EU tuition – i.e. \$147.50 per credit hour for coursework
- Credit in conjunction with missions work on the field under the Christian Service and Travel prefixes
- Content focused to serve unique missions emphasis
- Coursework available on-line from anywhere in the world

The first opportunity for AGWM personnel will be 6 credits in conjunction with PFO 2005. The courses will be held on Evangel's campus June 13 – 17, the week prior to PFO. Room and board will be \$75 for the week. Offerings include:

ANTH 232 Cross-Cultural Communications (2)

S. Friesen

Students study foundations, principles, and theories of communication and the impact of culture on communication.

FIN199 Personal Financial Freedom (3)

D. Wubbena

A study of fundamental personal finance issues including credit, banking, interest, taxes, investments, and insurance. The course will include entrepreneurial basics and methods of creating revenue and handling of finances with a focus on missions support and personal business ventures.

GNST100 College Success (1)

L. Wellborn

A course designed to assist students in adjusting to University life, and processes associated with distance learning. Students will be introduced to essential academic skills and the application of critical thinking skills and a personal Christian world-view to life decisions. Students will investigate and practice specific academic skills, by inquiry into life skills necessary for citizenship in any diverse community, and by knowledge of history, traditions, and current campus life at Evangel.
